About the Project

The City of Saskatoon (City) will be rehabilitating storm sewer mains on Avenue D North from 29th Street to 30th Street. This work will improve the efficiency of the system and reduce future problems.

The work is scheduled to begin at 8:00 a.m. on August 28, 2017 and will proceed to other locations around the City into the fall.

The sanitary sewer lining will occur in two phases. The first phase involves the contractor cleaning and evaluating the condition of the pipe. During this phase the street may have parking and traffic restrictions, and is expected to last one day.

In the second phase, a liner will be installed in the existing sewer main. There may be short interruptions to your water and sewer services during this process. The contractor will advise you of any interruptions closer to the actual lining date. This phase is expected to last only a few hours.

During installation, there may be short interruptions to your sewer service. However, the City is not expecting any water outages. If during course of construction water and sewer service are required to be interrupted, the Contractor will advise you of such interruptions. In case of water interruption, a Drinking Water Advisory (DWA) will be sent out to your residence. If you receive a DWA, please follow the instructions on the card.

Thank you for your cooperation and patience during this project.

Other Facts About the Project:

- Insituform Technologies Ltd. has been contracted to complete the work.
- While the work is underway, signage will be installed; however, we ask that you stay clear of the work zone for your safety.
- During construction, heavy equipment may be used which has some noise and vibration.
- There may be odour resulting from the sanitary sewer lining.

Frequently Asked Questions

Will there be traffic restrictions?

Yes. There may be some short-term traffic restrictions as the project progresses. Signs will be posted directing drivers to alternate routes as required. Please follow the posted signs.

Will parking be affected?

Yes. For households/businesses directly adjacent to the work in progress, access to driveways and street parking will be restricted and alternative parking will need to be used around the neighbourhood.

Will my garbage and recycling collection services be affected?

No. The garbage and recycling collection services will not be affected.

Will my water and/or sewer service be affected?

No. Households should not experience any interruption to their water or sewer services during this work.

Will the bus routes change?

Bus routes along the construction route may be affected throughout the project. During construction, please check the signs posted for alternate bus stop locations or call Saskatoon Transit at 306-975-3100.

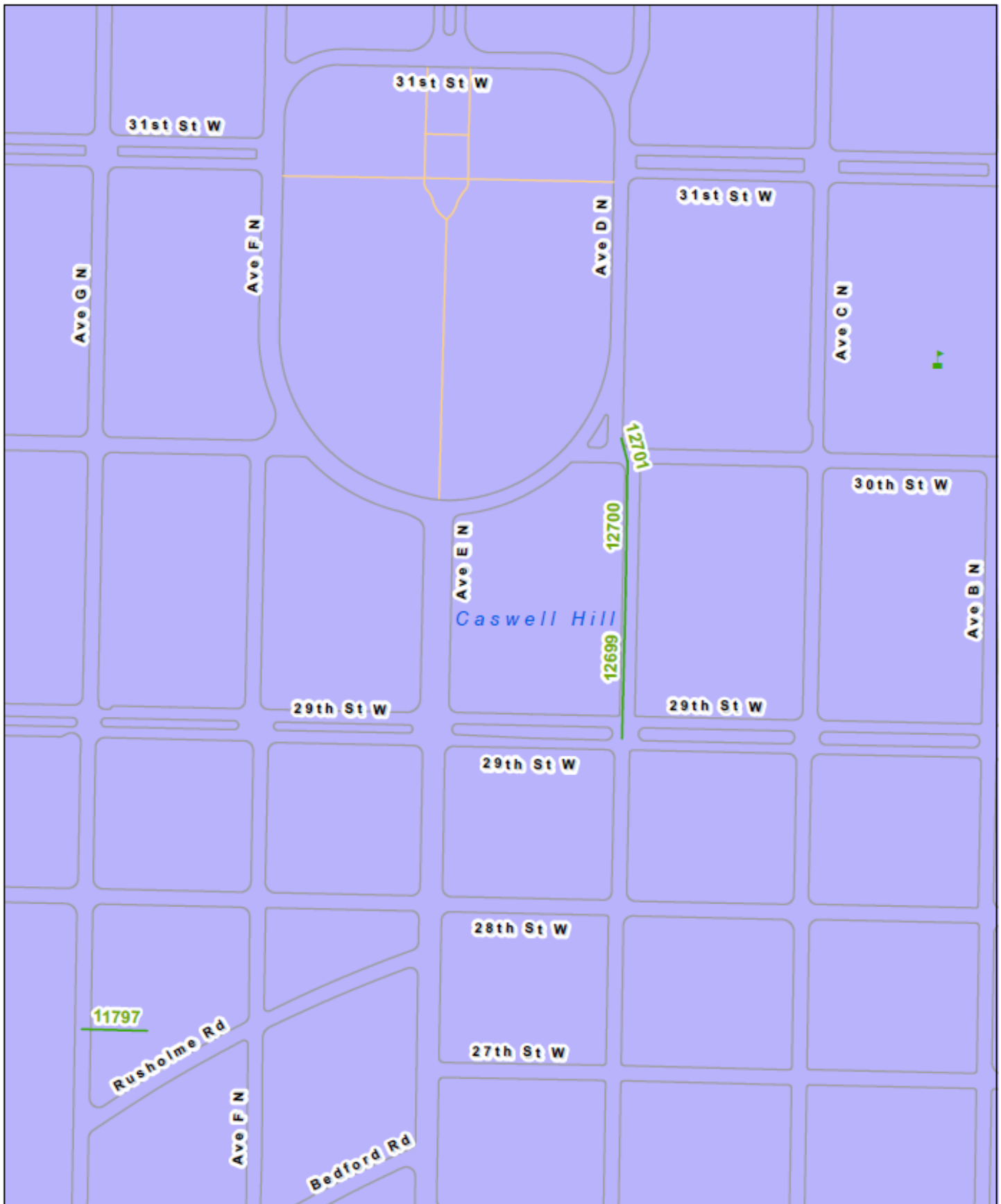
