“I would rather play this game than be in the classroom”


“Yes, I did have a lot of fun”

Lawn Bowling is played in over 40 countries with more than 50 member national authorities. The home of the modern game is still Scotland. This sport is one of the "core sports" that must be included at each edition of the Commonwealth Games.


The Mayfair Lawn Bowling Club has been actively rolling bowls in Ashworth-Holmes Park since 1925. Anyone from the ages of 9 and up can join at any time and we offer free introductory lessons. The game combines strategy, skill, social interaction, some degree of exercise, affordability, competition, and FUN.

We provide lessons to many Saskatoon high school students, host Provincial tournaments, provide coaches for private rentals, and of course we compete against other members.

The Object of the game is to roll your bowl on a grass surface at least 21 m and get closer to a small white ball, the target, than your opponent. If you succeed, then your team scores. One catch is the bowls do not roll in a straight line but turn as they slow down.

There are local, Provincial, National, and International tournaments both for those with sight and blind competitors.
