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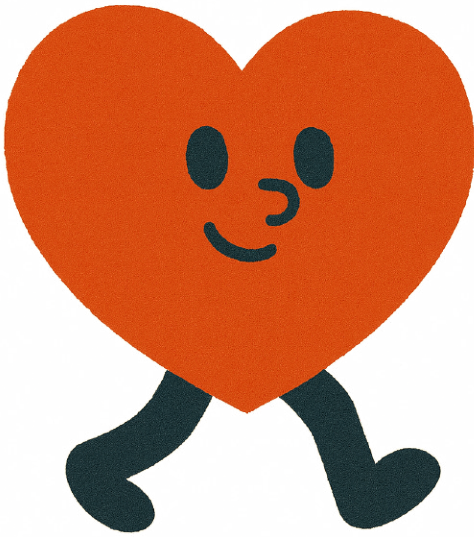
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Join your community association!

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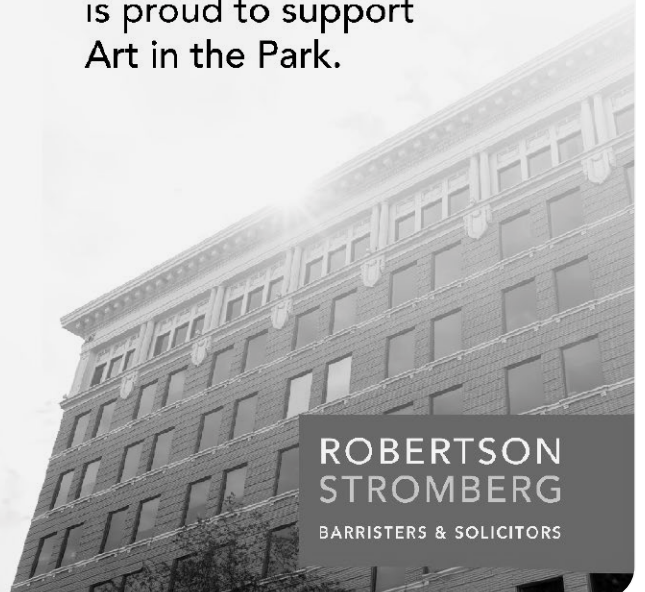

The Shelter on 31st

Let's talk about the shelter.

For those unfamiliar, the City of Saskatoon and the Province of Saskatchewan are building a 24-hour, 60-bed shelter on 31st Street, on the east side of Idylwyld. It is scheduled to open in Spring 2027 and will be operated by the Mustard Seed.

We, the Community Association, responded with a letter outlining some high-level ideas to shape the project in a positive and constructive manner. That letter marked the beginning of an ongoing relationship

between us, the City of Saskatoon, the Province of Saskatchewan, and the Police, Fire, and Mustard Seed teams.

As always, our aim is to respect everyone in Caswell Hill, including the area's residents and Saskatoon's most vulnerable alike.

We've since begun regular monthly meetings with all involved parties to bring together the concerns of fellow Caswellians, streamline conversations, and get ahead of anticipated challenges.

It's worth noting there are related developments planned nearby, including a 24-hour drop-in centre at 130 Idylwyld Drive, as well as a rehabilitation centre at 912 Idylwyld Drive.

Dearest Neighbours,

We're probably biased – okay, we're absolutely biased – but we genuinely believe Caswell Hill is something special. And that's entirely because of the people in it. Our city's most vulnerable and the impacts of their complex and compounding struggles can't be ignored. And the truth is, this work is always worth it – and always easier – with constant reminders of what this place has to offer: children's laughter surrounding the parks, playgrounds, ice rink and pool, songbirds, bees buzzing from flower garden to flower garden, the mature tree canopy that defines our streets and our skyline (quick sidenote if you think you've spotted Dutch Elm disease, please request tree inspections at 306-975-2476 and if you want more trees in Caswell use the city's *Request a Tree* program.)

This past year has brought a particular wealth of highlights. Community Rink Day returned in February – a beloved tradition, and a personal triumph for one child (who shall go unnamed) as he ate 15, yes 15, free hot dogs. Volunteer Appreciation Day gave us the chance to honour the quiet, tireless work that keeps things running. And after a six-year hiatus, Art in the Park will return June 13 & 14 – mark your calendars as this event is a reminder that beauty is all around us. Our community partners at the Bus Barns have also brought life into the building as artists have begun working and creating in the space – a meaningful moment in our history, honouring our past while stepping into a new chapter. Taken together, these moments tell a story of real momentum.

As we look ahead, we do so with relentless optimism and empathy. There are real challenges to navigate and real improvements to be made – and we'd love for you to be part of it. Whether you have a fresh idea, a spare hour, or simply a desire to see Caswell Hill flourish, our board and volunteer network are open to you. Margaret Mead put it well: "Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful, committed citizens can change the world; indeed, it's the only thing that ever has."

Thank you for reading this. Thank you for being part of this story. Thank you for making Caswell Hill what it is – a neighbourhood with grit, character, and hope.
